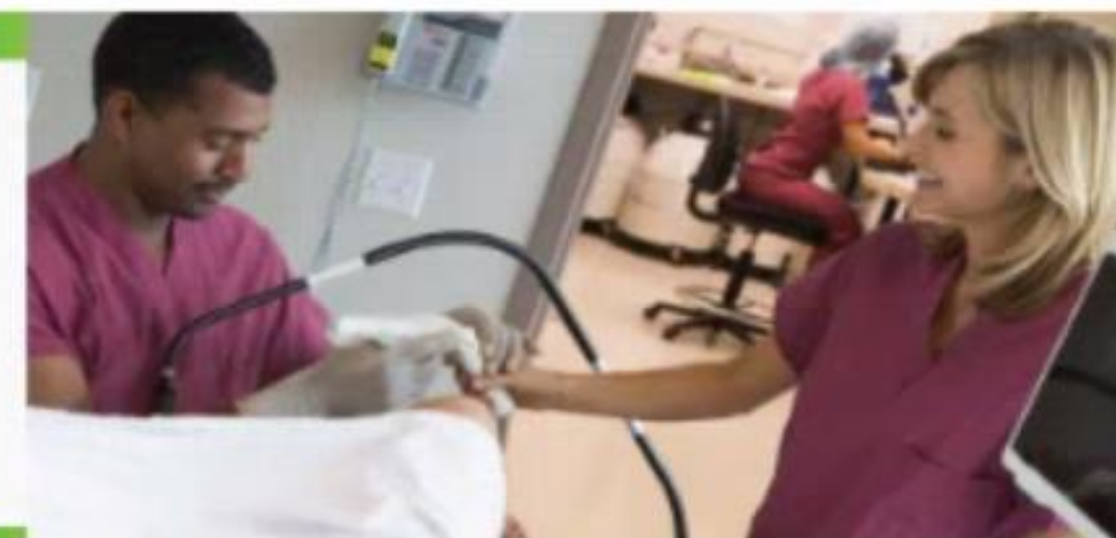

The next exam will be held in Copenhagen, Denmark on Saturday 4 July 2020. The exam will be fully electronic using the platform provided by ESHRE. Applications **open on 15 October 2019 and close on 31 May 2020** (or until maximum capacity is reached). Applications will be reviewed, and candidates will be informed by the end of April 2020.

Requirements

- be an **ESHRE member**
- hold a nursing or midwifery **degree** (*)
- provide evidence of your degree **in English** (**)
- have a comprehensive understanding of the **English** language
- two years of clinical **experience** as a MAR nurse or midwife when submitting the logbook
- submit a digital **logbook** including one ethical dilemma (completed over a maximum of two years)
- pay a non-refundable **fee** of 50 Euro
- pass the **exam**, with a minimum score of 66%, within three years after having the digital logbook and ethical cases

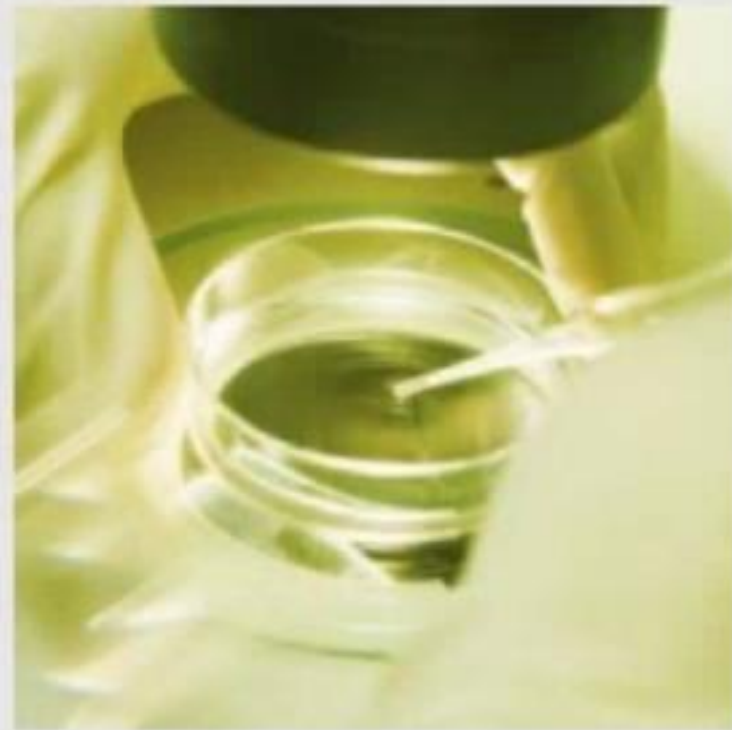

For 2019 only logbooks completed digitally will be accepted.

You will have to include:

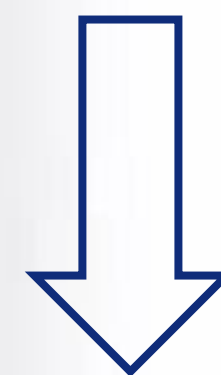
- the name and city of the clinic where you observed/assisted to/performed a procedure
- date of the procedure
- whether you have observed (O), assisted (A) or performed (P) the procedure (to observe: to watch carefully the way something happens or the way someone does something, to assist: to help someone else, to perform: to do an action without help from someone else). For each action you need to circle the appropriate letter O A P. If only A/P is printed, you are required to assist or perform the procedure. If O is printed, you are only required to observe the procedure.
- the signature of the supervisor

We decided to make some additional rules for the case some techniques are not performed in your country. You can check them [here](#).

The supervisor (this may be a more experienced nurse, a doctor or someone performing the procedure in the daily practice) needs to confirm each logbook item. In the paper logbook (s)he will have to sign next to the procedure whereas in the digital logbook (s)he will receive an email to confirm you have covered the required procedures.

When submitting your online application, you will have to list the supervisors who can confirm your logbook actions. Please restrict the number of supervisors to 10.

The logbook needs to be completed within a maximum period of 2 years before the application deadline.

- *94 'multiple choice questions' for which you need to select a single most correct answer from four options. For each correct answer you earn 1 point. You do not lose points by giving incorrect answers.*
- *One 'scenario-based question' in which you need to answer one lead-in question based on the description of a patient scenario and two additional questions. All three questions should be answered by selecting the most correct option from the list. For each correct answer you earn 2 points, equaling six points in total. You do not lose points by giving incorrect answers.*
