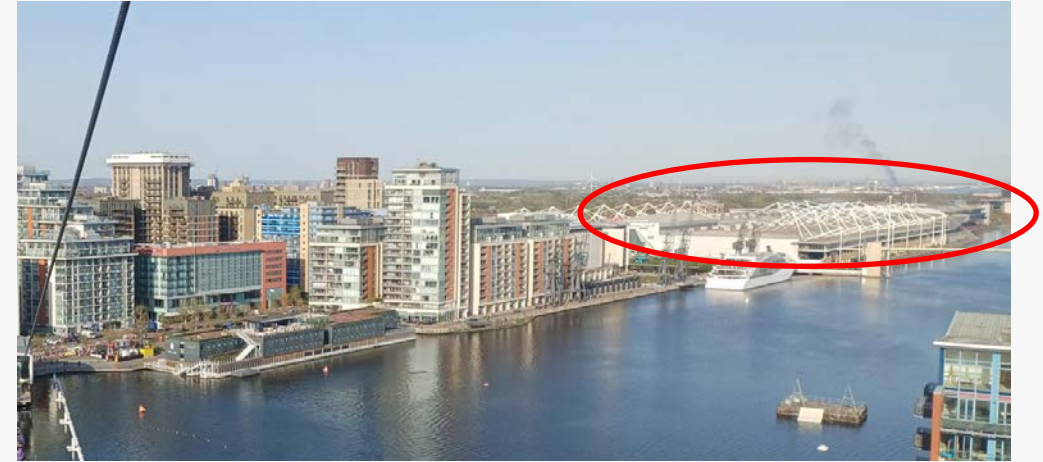

- No heavy material can be brought in anymore
- All aisles need to be clean and empty
- Only booth decoration inside the booth is allowed
- No "dirty" works are allowed



Onsite Access - stand builders & stand holders

From Thursday 2 July 08:00 till Saturday 4 July before 13:00

- Stand builders and exhibitors can only access the exhibit hall with an **orange wrist band**

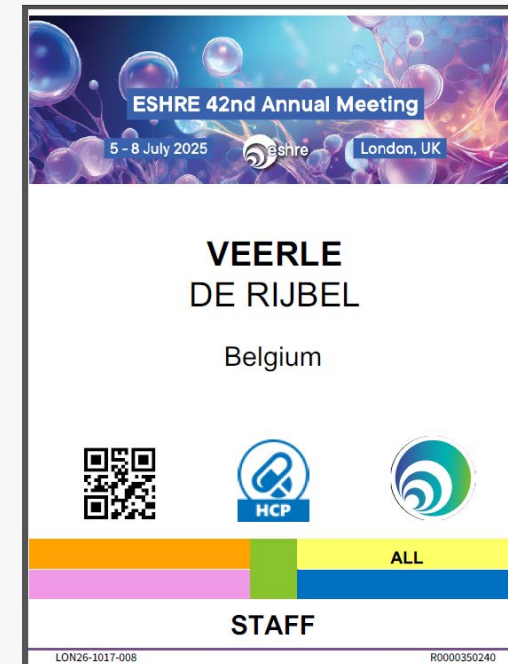
From Saturday 4 July after 13:00 till the end of the congress

- Exhibitors wearing a **congress badge with an orange line** have access to all zones of the exhibit hall during build-up, booth walkthrough, the congress days (incl. outside exhibition opening hours), and during breakdown
- Exhibitors/booth staff wearing an **orange wrist band** have access to all zones of the exhibit hall during build-up and the booth walkthrough (new) until **Sunday, 5 July 20:00**, and during breakdown

Exhibitor badges

The exhibitor badges will have one or two colours:

- Pink** = access to exhibit during opening hours (Mon-Tue: 08:30-17:00, Wed: 08:30-14:00)
- Orange** = access to exhibit during build-up, during the congress days, outside opening hours, and during breakdown





Orange wrist bands

Dates and times pick-up

- **Build-up:** Thursday, 2 July from 08:00 until Sunday, 5 July 17:00
- **Dismantling:** Wednesday, 8 July from 15:00 until 21:00 and on Thursday, 9 July from 08:00 until 20:00

Pick-up location

- **Security** will distribute **orange wristbands** directly to stand builders until Sunday, 5 July 17:00
- **Boothwalkthrough** access after 17:00 on Sunday, 5 July: **orange wristbands** can be collected at the Exhibitors Desk (Titia) by the stand's main contact person until 20:00. **Titia needs to know how many wristbands you need by 26 June.**

Pick-up list (Thursday 02/07 to Saturday 04/07)

- In order to receive an **orange wrist band**, any stand builder/exhibitor needs to be on Excel's security list
- To be on this list they need to watch a mandatory safety induction video and complete a form in advance – see QR code

!!! Mandatory safety induction video & form !!!

- Only mandatory from **Thursday 02/07 to Saturday 04/07**
- Anyone requiring access to the exhibition hall during build-up or breakdown must watch the induction video and complete a form – please scan below QR code or click on <https://lymcreative.com/eshre>, to watch the video
- If this has not been completed in advance, it must be done on-site before access to the exhibition hall will be granted, If not the security won't let you in
- The video takes about 4 minutes





Safety first

- Safety shoes are not mandatory during build-up and breakdown. However, **high visibility vests** are mandatory on:
 - Thursday 02/07
 - Friday 03/07
 - Saturday 04/07
- As of Sunday 05/07 it's not necessary anymore to wear high visibility vests
- During breakdown high visibility vests are mandatory again in the exhibit hall on:
 - Wednesday 08/07
 - Thursday 09/07
- Construction workers, however, will need to wear safety shoes and a helmet when carrying out work involving tools or machinery
- In case anyone has forgotten their high-visibility vest, these can be purchased from the on-site shop 'Business Services' at Excel. The shop is located at Level 0
- Opening times Business Services shop: 08:00 - 17:00 (until 20:00 during last day of build and break)

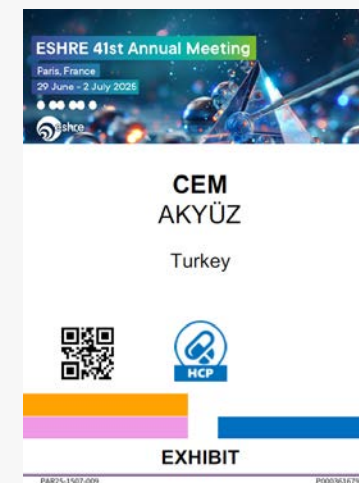
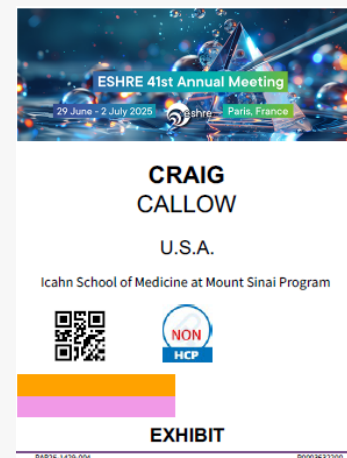




Booth Walkthroughs

Some exhibitors will organise booth walkthroughs for their staff once their stand set-up has been completed:

- Booth walkthroughs can take place between **17:00 and 20:00 on Sunday, 5 July**
- Exhibitors who are already in the exhibition hall before 17:00 can remain in the hall until 20:00, until the Opening Reception begins
- Access to the exhibition hall during the booth walkthrough is restricted to exhibitors/booth staff wearing either:
 - a **congress badge with an orange line**, or
 - an **orange wristband**
- Orange wristbands can be collected at the Exhibitors Desk (Titia) by the stand's main contact person. **Titia needs to know how many wristbands you need for your booth walkthrough by 26 June.**

- It will be a grab and go with prepared lunch bags. Only the exhibitors who are wearing a **badge with the orange line** will have access to the Exhibitor Lounge

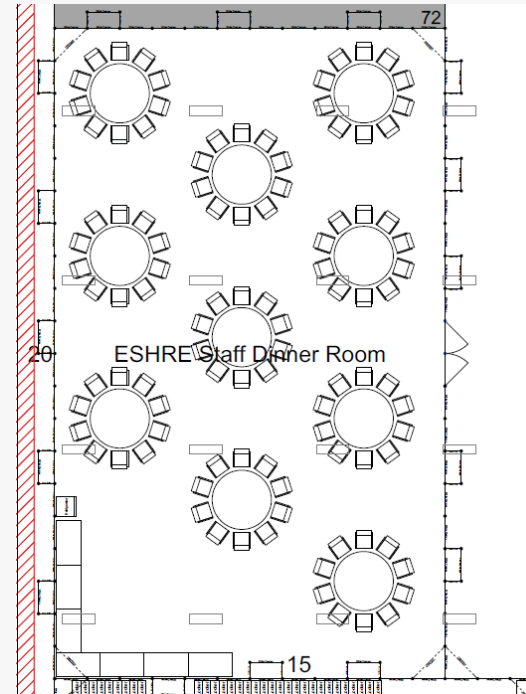




Exhibit Compliance

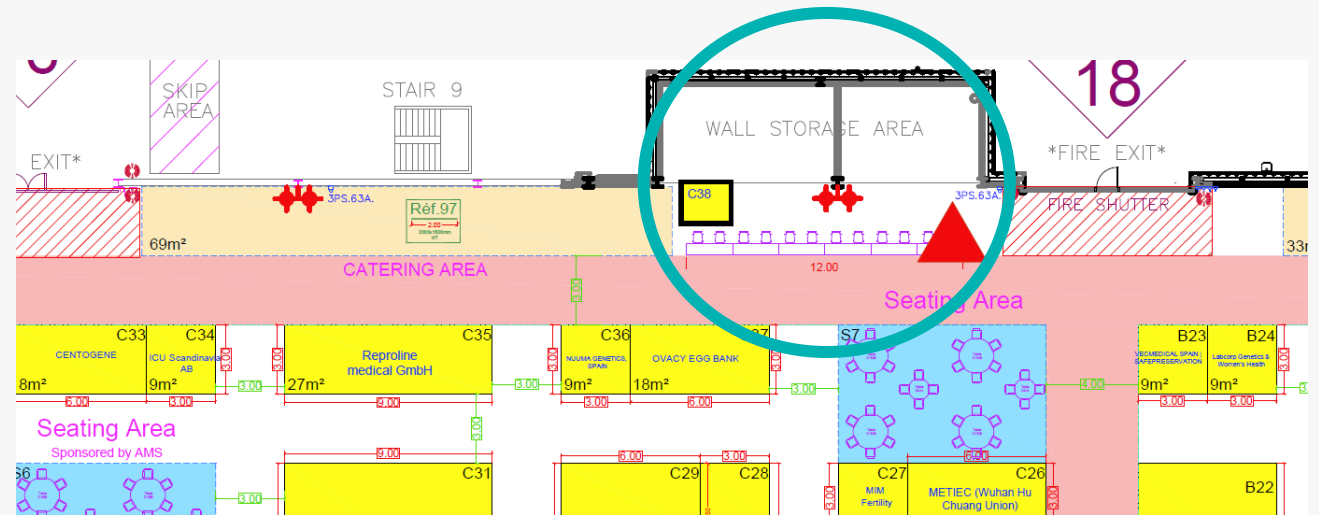


Exhibitors desk

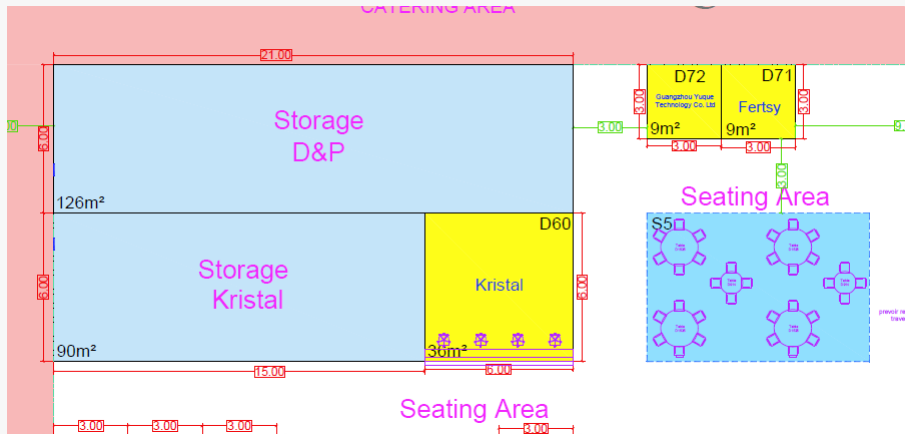

Parking

- ExCel's undercroft car park has a maximum height restriction of 2.8m. If the van does not exceed this height, it will be able to park in the car park. Important to note, this car park is always chargeable
- Parking rates:
 - Pre-booked parking: £27.50 per calendar day (00:00–23:50)
 - On-site, pay-on-exit parking: £30.00 per calendar day (00:00–23:59)
- ExCel recommends pre-booking parking where possible, please see the booking link for any exhibitors wishing to book parking:

- If the van exceeds the maximum height, ExCel can offer alternative parking in the North West Lorry Car Park and East Overflow Car Park. Please note that parking in the overflow car park is subject to availability and operates on a first-come, first-served basis. Spaces cannot be reserved or guaranteed
- To access these alternative car parks, the driver will need to report to the Traffic Office on Sandstone Lane after unloading, where traffic marshals will direct them if space is available. Parking in these areas is free during build and break days. However, during live show days, parking is chargeable based on vehicle size. For a van, the charge is £30 per day



Badge scanners / Lead retrievals

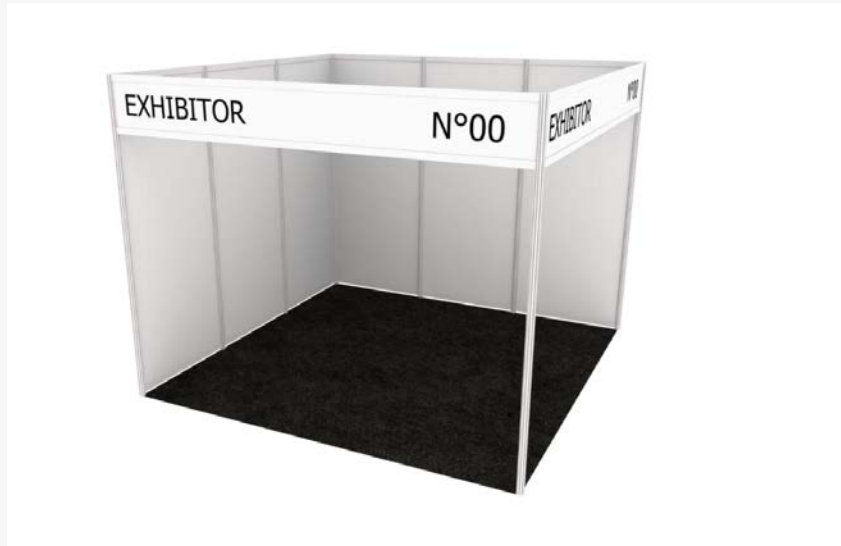
- Before the start of the congress exhibitors have the possibility to order badge scanners with COVR
- With these badge scanners the exhibitors can scan the delegates' badges and retrieve their contact details
- Simba from COVR, who will be sitting at the Exhibitors' Desk in the registration area, will take care of these badge scanners. The exhibitors can only pick up the scanners at Simba's desk and should return all badge scanners to Simba when the exhibit is closed for visitors

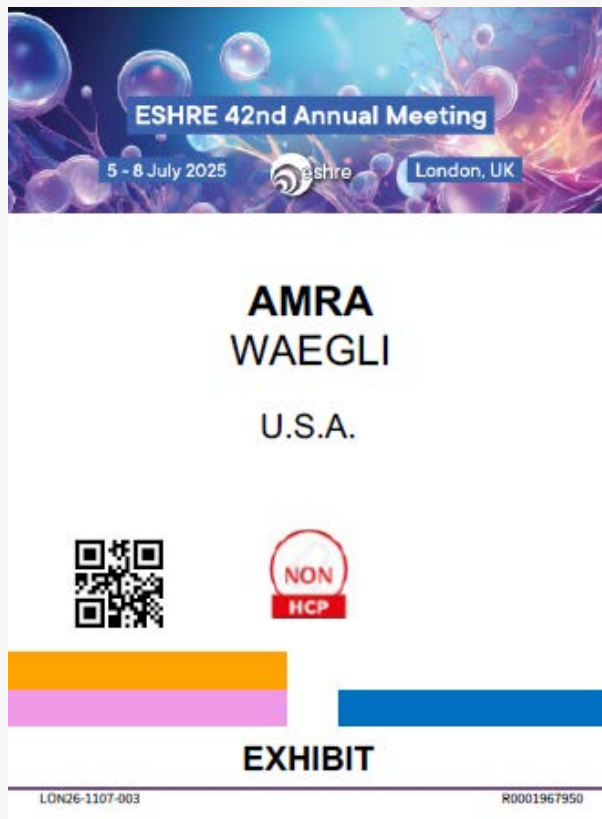
All badges have one or more coloured blocks on the bottom of the front side.

There are five colours

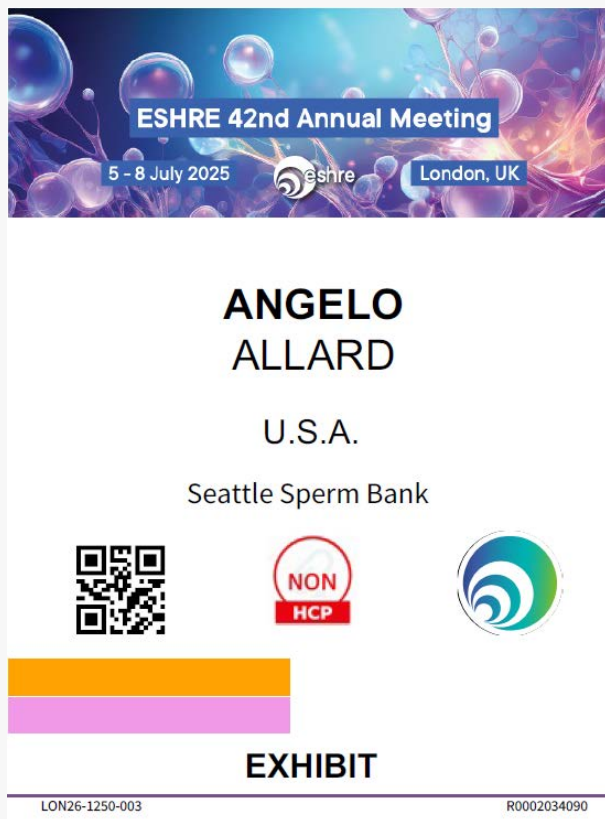
- **Yellow** = access to a Precongress Course on Sunday

- **Green** = access to a committee/company meeting outside official opening hours or if not registered for ESHRE 2025



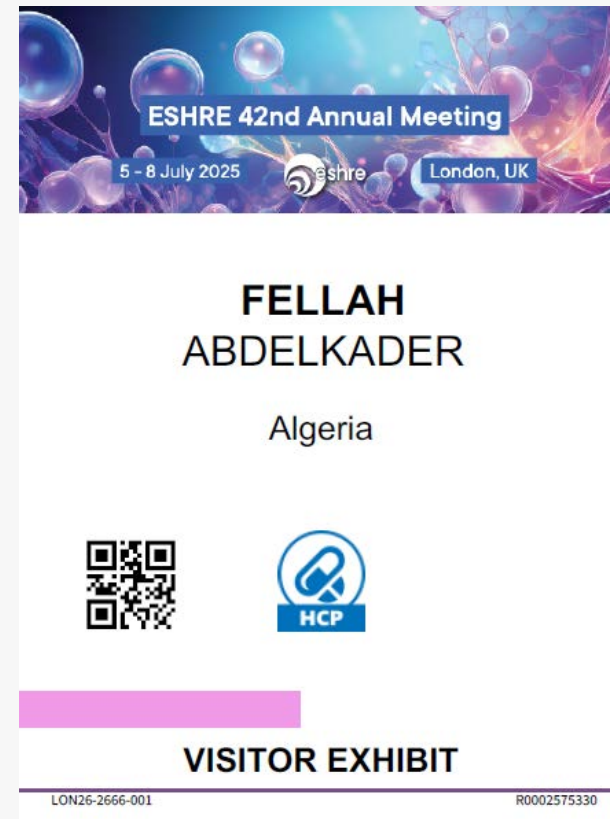

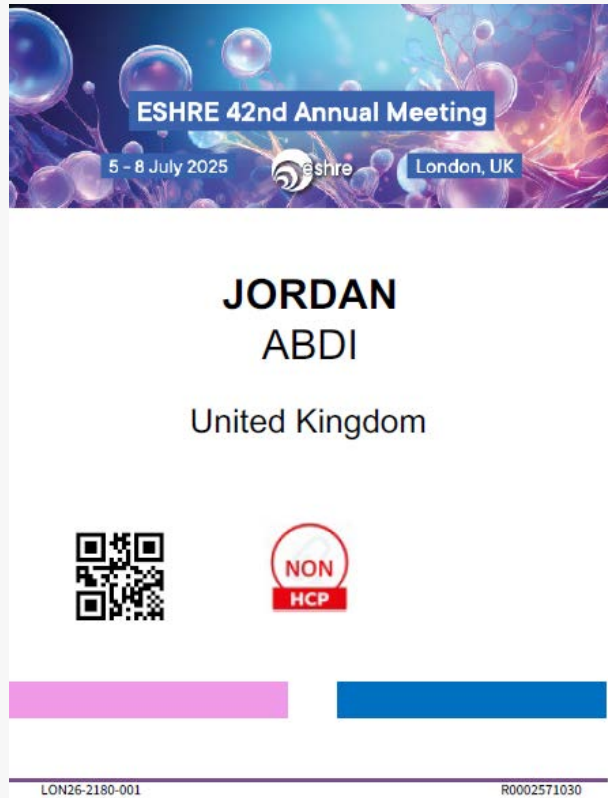

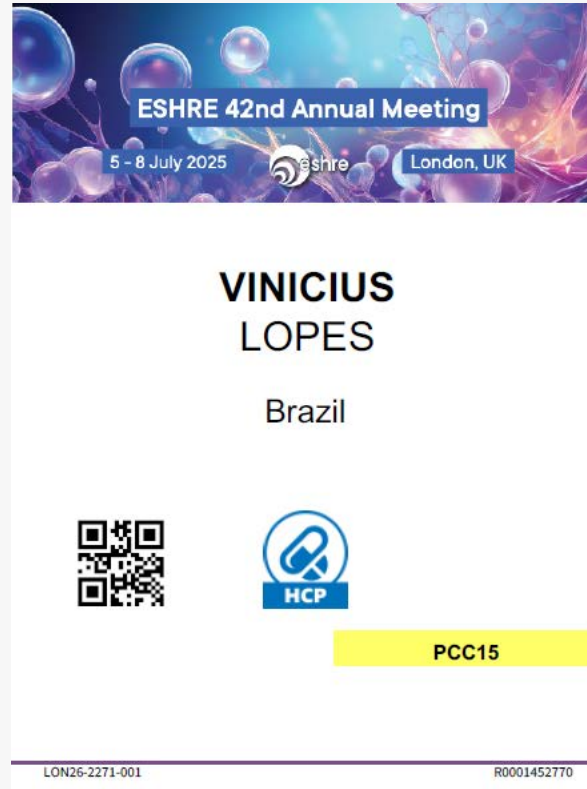

Useful stuff to remember...

Travel from London St. Pancras to ExCeL

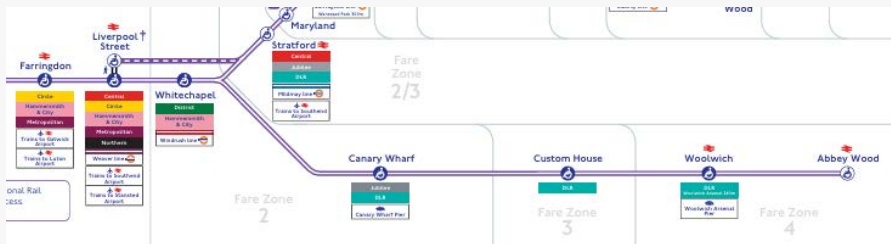
The easiest and quickest way to move around in London is with public transportation.

When leaving the Eurostar terminal, go to the right in the direction of Platform A (= Southbound) where you take the Thameslink. Get off in Farringdon (one stop).

In Farringdon, take the Elizabeth line in the direction of Abbey Wood. Get off in Custom House (4th stop), ExCeL's West Entrance



Instead of buying a ticket, you can easily tap in tap out with a credit card (one credit card per person).





Useful stuff to remember...

- ✓ Abstract book → version with blanked out embargoed abstracts will be published on our website on 29-30 June → on 8 July (after the last session) the final version including the embargoed abstracts, will be published at the OUP website
- ✓ Lost and found → The hostesses will be instructed to bring items to the VIP registration desk
- ✓ Cloakroom → service for participants is free of charge
- ✓ Children under the age of 18 are not permitted beyond the registration area, in the exhibit hall or any other halls/areas. ESHRE does not organise childcare facilities.
- ✓ No public transportation tickets



Useful stuff to remember...

- ✓ ATM machine → There is one ATM between N4 and N5 and one on the lower ground car park level between S5 and N5. Should you require one outside of the venue, there is also an ATM nearby at the Tesco Express near the Royal Docks Cable Car station which can be accessed by following the Western Gateway.
- ✓ Foreign currency ATM → There is a Travelex ATM by the S11 entrance on the boulevard.
- ✓ Currency exchange office → The Service Business shop on level 0 at the bottom of the stairs near N4/S4 has its own Bureau de Change.
