

# Covid-19 & ART pregnancies

Help us improve our understanding of SARS-CoV-2 infection in fertility treatment



Only limited data are currently available on the effects of COVID-19 on pregnancy, and even less on its specific impact on pregnancies achieved from assisted reproduction. The COVID-19 working group of ESHRE has put in place an online questionnaire on COVID-19 and ART pregnancies to facilitate case reporting.

The data can be easily reported and collected, and comprises information on the infection, the fertility treatment, the pregnancy, and the neonatal and obstetric outcomes.

**We encourage you to report the cases of your patients infected with SARS-CoV-2 during their fertility treatment or pregnancy to contribute to our study.**

The data collection is anonymous. No patient can be identified.


