Intrauterine Insemination

Standard therapy for non-tubal factor.

Cost effective procedure.

Success dependent upon OI regimen and seminal parameters.

Pregnancy rates for 3 cycles approach IVF rates.

Female Fertility and IUI

- FSH (~<15 IU/L)
- Endometriosis (stage I-II)
- Open tubes
- Anovulatory
- Cervical factor

Sperm Chromatin integrity Antisperm Antibodies

IUI-Male

- Semen wash
- Remove prostaglandins
- Remove debris, WBC's, abnormal sperm
- Capacitating conditions-enhanced motility
 - Increased platelet-activating factor (PAF) utilization
 - Platelet-activating factor acetylhydrolase activity affects sperm motility and serves as a decapacitation factor. Zhu et al. Fertil Steril 2006;85(2):391-394.

IUI Outcomes

5-10% 10-15% 20-25% • Timed intercourse Clomid Gonadotropins


- Sperm Motility Enhancers
 cAMP
 hFF
 Xanthine
 Gaffeine
 Pentoxityline
 Platielet Activating Factor (PAF)
 The advantage of such a treatment is that PAF is a natural substance that is non-toxic as it, is with many other motility stimulators (Henkel & Schill Reprod Biol Endo 2003;1:108-130.

What is PAF?

- Platelet-Activating Factor
 - Phospholipid
 - Occurs naturally in sperm
 - Role in capacitation/acrosome reaction
 - Improves sperm motility

- Immune System
- Neural System
- Urogenital System
- Gastrointestinal System
- Reproductive System


Effect of PAF on Sperm Function


- Hyperactivation

- Pregnancy outcomes














IUI Outcomes

 Timed intercourse 	5-10%
 Clomid 	10-15%
 Gonadotropins 	20-25%
Injectable with PAF	30-35%
Pen with PAF	?%

What is the "Gonadotropin Pen"?

- Unique system for administering gonadotropin solution
- Device for multiple use and flexible dosing
- Significant advantages
 - Pre-mixed, ready for use cartridges
 - Improved patient compliance
 - Decreased patient stress
 - Increased dose delivery consistency



Total dose of gonadotropin, IU*	1070 ± 580.3

≥15 mm	2.0 (1-4)
≥18 mm	1.0 (0-2)
Ovulation rate, n (%)	41 (95.3)
Biochemical PR per attempt, n (%)	15 (34.9)
Ongoing PR per attempt in (%)	13 (30.2)

IUI Outcomes • Timed intercourse 5-10% • Clomid 10-15% • Gonadotropins 20-25% • Injectable with PAF 30-35% • Pen with PAF ~40%
