PCCs

- 2020: How safe is MAR really and how far can we go in the manufacturing of a child? Program is okay, all speakers confirmed.
- 2021: collaboration with SIG-early pregnancy (topic: early pregnancy loss and miscarriage) The idea is interesting to the group and we are going to pursue this.

 - Proposal SIG Ethics and Law – ‘Errors in ART’ (proposed date November 2020 , probably in Greece) – preliminary program looked fine and interesting. The group finds this a very interesting idea and will fine-tune the program together with SIG Ethics and law
 - Proposal SIG SQART: campus course on organisational skills on how to run an IVF centre / lab (including leadership, training, QM, people management skills etc..). Venue: Rome, proposed date: April / May 2021 (running title: Rome wasn’t built in a day ☺)
 - Proposal SIG-E (on KPI) – Ljubljana Slovenia -> moved a later date –This group of the clinical KPIs first need to finalize the indicators and work more on the content of this project. To be continued.
