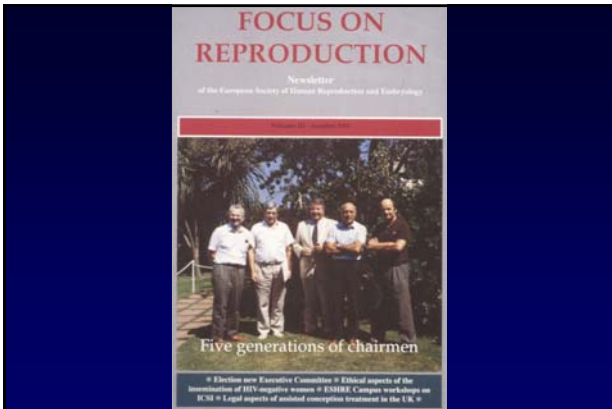




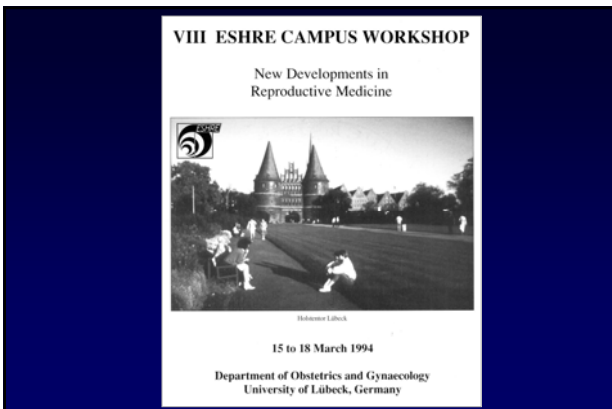

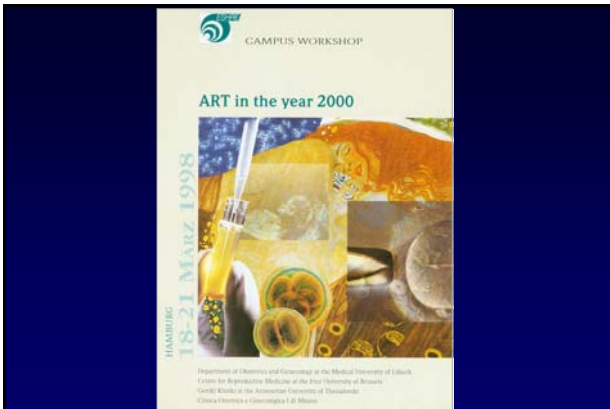

Summary

- Future studies: prospective follow up of cohorts regarding complications in general
- Comparison: cryopreservation of all embryos in antagonist/agonist triggered cycles
- Single embryo replacement
- Epigenetic alterations in gametes/embryos/neonates
- Further studies on prediction of adverse psychological events
- PGS: research tool; no evidence based benefit
- Longer term follow up still required
